FAN BUS- Boys Basketball Sectional

Due to Southwestern (Shelby) High School being a 78 mile drive, there will be a fan bus for each game (W,F & S) that Rising Sun plays in the boys basketball sectional at Southwestern (Shelby). The Rising Sun Athletic Department is strongly encouraging all students planning on going to the Sectional games to ride the fan bus due to the distance and county roads required to get to the school. Any student wanting to ride the fan bus must sign the sign-up sheet on the bulletin board outside the office. All students riding the fan bus must have \$6 with them to purchase a single session ticket or purchase an all session ticket for \$10 in the office before the end of the day on Monday. Students signing up will be required to ride the fan bus to and from all sessions that Rising Sun is playing. Rising Sun will play Hauser on Wednesday, February 28th at approximately 7:30 PM. The fan bus will leave at 4:45 PM on Wednesday and for each day that Rising Sun plays.
