- the student has declared an education major (preferably elementary, but not limited to elementary majors)
- the student must complete an application for the scholarship which is available through the Rising Sun High School Guidance Office
- the student's activities in and out of school will be considered
- an official transcript of the student's hours and grades must be submitted with the application
